Migration tool for student assets

Make it easy for your students to take their Creative Cloud assets with them after graduation.

Adobe now offers a new way for your recent graduates to migrate their Adobe Creative Cloud assets from school-assigned accounts to new [Creative Cloud free membership](#) accounts.

With just a few clicks, students will be able to have ongoing access to their assets, including their work like Adobe Photoshop images and Illustrator graphics, and Adobe Portfolio and Behance profiles. By migrating their assets, they'll be able to showcase their work to future employers long after graduation. And they'll be eligible for special Adobe offers that ease the transition to the workforce or graduate school.

Here's what it takes for students to migrate their assets:

- They must still have access to their school-assigned accounts.
- The new student asset migration tool must be enabled in the Admin Console.
